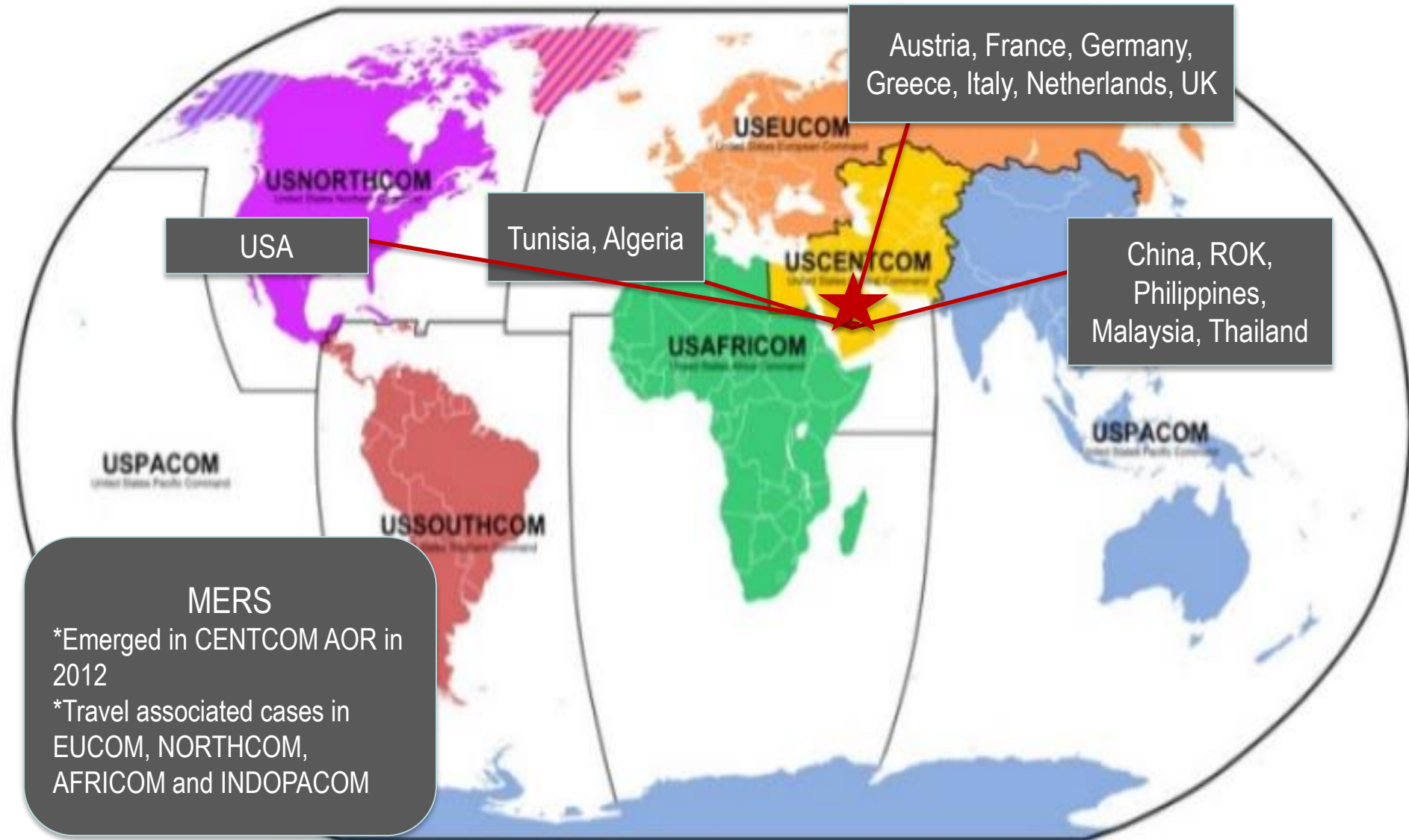

GHE enhances collaboration with foreign ministries and civil structures

REGIONAL STABILITY

GHE contributes to social well-being, rule of law, governance, economics, and security
