Major General Jerry Sanders Scholarship for Healthcare Careers
General Instructions

AMSUS – The Society of Federal Health Professionals will award up to three \$1,000 scholarships in 2021 for students pursuing a healthcare related career. The AMSUS Scholarship program is funded by an endowment from TRIWEST Healthcare Alliance and is named for Maj Gen Jerry Sanders, USAF, MC (Ret).

Major General Sanders retired from the Air Force in 1991 as the Deputy Surgeon General. He is a Life member of AMSUS and a former member of the AMSUS Board of Directors. General Sanders is a former Vice President of Medical Affairs for TRIWEST Healthcare Alliance.

Download and complete the required information and save the file for your records. Email the application, a pdf of your most recent transcripts along with a photo to awards@amsus.org by June 30, 2021.

Criteria

- Applicant must be an active individual or Life member of AMSUS or an immediate family member (spouse, child or grandchild) of an active AMSUS member.
- High school senior or graduate who plans to enroll, or students already enrolled, in a full time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the upcoming academic year.
- Academic careers can include, medicine, nursing, hospital administration, pharmacy, biomedical sciences, or veterinary medicine.
- Students on HPSP Scholarship are not eligible.
- Students selected to attend a military academy are not eligible.
- This program is only for students and school programs in the United States at this time.

Selection Process

Applications will be reviewed, and awardees selected, by a subcommittee of the AMSUS Board of Directors. Applicants agree to accept the decision of the subcommittee as final.

Scholarship nominations will be evaluated on the following:

- Their academic record
- Demonstrated citizenship as illustrated in leadership and community activities
- Quality and content of the essay reflecting their demonstrated compassion and commitment to service
- Work experience

How recipients will be notified

Recipients will be notified by email NLT July 30, 2021. Announcements will be made in on the AMSUS website, via social media and in the weekly SmartBrief newsletter. Scholarship awardees will also be announced during the annual Awards Luncheon/Banquet in February 2022.

The check will be made payable to the applicant and mailed to the address on the application in mid-August. It is requested that the check be deposited as soon as it is received.

Winners will also receive a complimentary 1-year AMSUS membership to begin September 2021. Winners will be added to the database and sent membership information so they can access and update their information.
