Continuing Education Information

- Identify women's health as a key component of force health, impacting both individual and unit readiness, and discuss recent advances in women's health positively impacting access to care for Service women.
- Summarize the importance of publishing research, quality improvement and case reports in the peer-reviewed literature to improve patient care.
- Identify existing and future technologies to aid in delivering health care under attack in a cyber-degraded environment.
